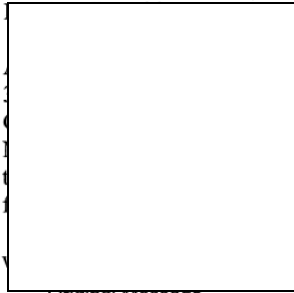

Keith has made changes to the Energy Efficiency protocols according to our feedback...please review and send in your comments no later than end of day on **Wednesday – April 25th**...Best to have all comments cc'ing one another so others can provide input on any issues that arise.

For Steve and Jake...the gist of our discussion was:

1. Energy project assessments were the focus (as opposed to energy audits which are more formal, expensive and comprehensive) -so we had to build common guidance to undertaking an assessment and who would likely be qualified to do the assessment.
2. Find ways of referencing current resources and develop new resources that would benchmark energy profiles (baselines) for future EE offset projects...in the short term, item 1 above is guidance.
3. Rick and Ron agreed that the protocol covers the breadth of projects that they've been involved in.

Hope you agree once you see the revised protocol.

Thanks for all your efforts Guys! These will likely be adaptable to other systems in Canada and abroad...since they're based on the international standard.
