Hi All - apologies if you've received this already...

Our Premier has set some aggressive timelines for establishing the regulatory framework for Greenhouse Gases in Alberta – it caught us all by surprise. July 1, 2007 was supposed to be January 1, 2008. I've been seconded to Climate Change Central to help get the Offset market up and running - providing market tools and infrastructure to do so. We've developed a Waste Heat Recovery protocol, that you've all seen before, and need some technical input and review on that Protocol as part of the Alberta development process. As in all the protocols we've drafted, we've followed the approach developed through the old National Offset Quantification Team and Environment Canada's Guide to Protocol development document (issued March 2006).
