Deleted word electricity under the description of the equation for SS's P5, P6, P7, P11, B1 and B4 as this reference to electricity was a typo that had been copied and pasted throughout the table by mistake since the formulas are all specific to fossil fuel consumption, and do not include electricity consumption.	Deleted a confusing sentence that was copied and pasted in the protocol to improve the clarity of the document. This was only an editorial change and did not affect the quantification.
2nd	Page 4	Bullet point #5, under flexibility	None. Editorial change by the protocol developer to improve wording of the document.	Moved Flexibility Mechanism #5 to the Applicability section as it was meant to be an applicability criterion that must be followed, not a flexibility mechanism.	Clarification of a copy and paste error.
2nd	Page 1	Bullet point #3, under eligibility/ applicability	None. Editorial change by the protocol developer to improve wording of the document.	Deleted Applicability Criterion #3. Criterion was redundant and unclear. Criterion #1 already addresses the requirement for supplemental energy inputs.	Deleted redundant information for clarity, no impact on protocol scope or quantification.
2nd	Page 1	Bullet point #3, under eligibility/ applicability	None. Editorial change by the protocol developer to improve wording of the document.	Deleted Applicability Criterion #4. Criterion was inconsistent with the definition of B11 Electricity Usage (which states that electricity may be generated on-site) and the existence of electricity generation under the baseline does not impact the project activity of implementing a WHR unit nor the quantification.	Deleted inconsistent wording for clarity, no impact on protocol scope or quantification.
